

**Background:**

According to the 9<sup>th</sup> MACHC, Action 9-12, the Electronic Chart Committee (ECC) was tasked with providing and updating the Regional List of Ports, which was originally prepared in 2004 (MACHC meeting in Cartagena) and intended to be used as a tool for developing a regional ENC scheme. This has been done, using additional information derived from the Lloyd's List Ports of the World 2008 and the Caribbean Shipping Association.

**Description of Graphics:**

The ports have been plotted on the attached set of graphics, depicting existing regional ENC coverage for IHO Usage Bands. The ENC coverage shown is drawn from the information on existing and planned ENC coverage provided by MACHC member countries in response to an earlier request. To keep the graphics clear and manageable, they have been broken down by Band Usage or Navigational Purpose as follows:
