Our hydrographic survey ship HNLMS Snellius has left the Bahamas and is resuming its regular hydrographic tasks in the Caribbean. HNLMS Johan de Witt, including its team of hydrographic sea riders, is currently preparing to depart. A complication is the higher sea states caused by hurricane Humberto. The hydrographic work proved very useful, for instance to find an alternative route for backloading the JWIT from Abaco providing better shelter from the swell.

This message finalizes our post-Dorian reporting activities to MACHC. We would like to share our appreciation for the reports from other MS and industry. The quick availability of a myriad of data and information in online portals proved to be invaluable.
