MACHC Integrated Chart Committee Wednesday, 12 October 2016 – Conference Call

1. Commencement of Call:

a. Welcome & Introductions:

The Chair of the MICC, John Nyberg, opened the Conference Call at 10:00 with the introductions of participants. The following participated in the call:

b. Approval of the Agenda:

The Agenda was presented. No further changes were suggested and the Agenda was accepted as proposed.

2. MICC Organization:

a. Participants List:

There was no change to the MICC Participant List, (see Annex B).

b. <u>Approval of Minutes from 13 July Conference Call:</u>

Jan Schaap had previously indicated that the phrase "pay as you play" in Section 3 of the July notes, should really be "pay as you sail". This had been corrected prior to today's Conference Call and no additional comments were received. c. MICC Administrative Actions:

 Action 7.1: (The U.S. to forward the list of gaps (resulting from the Ports Analysis Coverage Project) to the WEND WG) is **completed** and is covered in Section 3 of these notes. ii. Action 7.2: (Dedicate time at the December MICC meeting to develop a timeline for completing ENC coverage of the identified ports) is not due until the December Meeting in Brazil.

3. Port Analysis:

John Nyberg introduced Jesse Friedmann, who covered the Ports List which was previously provided prior to the call. Jesse displayed the list and asked Members to review it for potential follow-up discussions in December. Jesse further noted that the yellow highlighted Ports are areas where ENC coverage needs to be addressed. This List will serve as the basis for further analysis and resolution at the December meeting. John asked all Member States for any feedback between now and the December meeting to be forwarded directly to Jesse at Jesse.Friedmann@noaa.gov. Plans are to go through this list at the meeting and develop plans for resolving any gaps. This approach was agreed upon. John summarized the value of the Ports List and indicated that it will be a good part of the December discussions.

Thus, Action 7.1 is considered completed. The submission to the WEND Working Group on the approach to above task has been deferred until full agreement has been attained at the December meeting.

4. INT Charts:

a. Review of INT Chart Actions:

- i. Action 4.2: (The U.K. to forward their proposal to resolve the overlap issue between INT Charts 4025 and 4011 directly to Colombia for their consideration.) remains on-going. Chris Thorne reported that the UK is working on a couple solutions and at this point going through internal reviews. Dagoberto David (Colombia) agreed to this approach. Stephanie Vincent (UK) confirmed that a proposal has been forwarded to Colombia and is now working on a second plan which hopefully will be more acceptable.
- ii. Action 12: (Venezuela and UK to review limits for INT 4102) remains on-going. Chris Thorne (UK) indicated that Lee Truscott is working on a re-scheme, which is in progress. D A Rojas (Venezuela) added that a meeting with the UKHO is scheduled after the December MACHC in Brazil. Chris Thorne added that hopes are to have an update in time for the meeting.

b. INT Chart Coordinator:

John Nyberg asked the group if anyone is interested in serving as the MACHC INT Chart Coordinator. John further asked Members to think about serving as the INT Chart Coordinator and be prepared to comment at the Meeting in December.

<u>Action 10.1:</u> All Members to consider serving as the INT Chart Coordinator for MACHC and respond at the December Meeting. (All MICC Members)

Chris Thorne complimented John and NOAA for all the work they have been doing. John Nyberg also asked if anyone would be interested in the position of the MICC Chair. If there is interest in serving in this capacity, please feel free to contact John for more information.

c. <u>Updates to Current INT Chart Coverage:</u>

John Nyberg indicated that no new INT Charts had been made available since the last meeting. John did add that NOAA is still working on the Chart covering the Bahamas, Cuba and Florida. John also noted the continuing difficulty in communicating with Cuba but will follow-up directly with Cuba after the call.

Stephanie Vincent (UK) noted that the UK is expected to have INT 8089 and INT 8088 (GB Charts 1021 and 1022) available in January 2017. [A subsequent update notes that these charts will be published December 22, 2016]

5. Electronic Charts:

a. Review of Electronic Chart Actions:

- i. <u>Action 7.3:</u> (IC-ENC and Mexico to engage in direct communication to address the overlap and ENC release of Mexican ENCs issue, noting the status and expected course of action and report to the next meeting) is **on-going and deferred until December.** Mexico expects to send a proposal to IC-ENC for resolution. John Nyberg requested an update at the December meeting.
- ii. <u>Action 7.4:</u> (All Member States who have data on the MACHC ENC On-Line, provide updates by mid-November to Jesse Friedmann at <u>jesse.friedmann@noaa.gov</u>) remains active, as it is not due until mid-November.

However John Nyberg asked that all Member States look at the MACHC website catalog file and the MACHC ENC On-Line and report any updates to Jesse. Brazil indicated that they would have all their data ready and updated for the December meeting.

Jan Schaap (Netherlands) asked for clarification on the forwarding of data for inclusion and whether the forwarding is actually done by IC-ENC. Mike Hawes confirmed this and added that the next IC-ENC update would be November 17.

iii. Action 4.4 (France to get back to Anthony Klemm with further information on the Web Mapping Service available from France and the associated restrictions) is **closed**. It has been overtaken by new action 10.2.

John Nyberg_indicated that he plans to follow-up and contact PRIMAR and Eric Langlois with an appropriate request for data.

Action 10.2: MICC Chair to contact PRIMAR and Eric Langlois regarding a request for French data for use in ENC –On-Line. (John Nyberg)

- iv. Action 12.3: (James Harper (IC-ENC) to track the overlap/release issue as it pertains to Mexican ENCs) has been incorporated into Action 7.3 and is considered **completed.**
- v. Action 4.4: (Venezuela to provide update on the progress of ENC development in the Orinoco River area) remains as on-going. It was suggested that this be further discussed at the December meeting and that it be removed as an action, as it is redundant with standard Agenda Item "Updates/adjustments to Region B ENC scheme". D A Rojas added that there was some limited activity in the Orinoco River area.

b. ENC On-Line Update:

John Nyberg requested that all Member States that have data on ENC On-Line, or wish to add their data, please send it to Jesse Friedmann at jesse.friedmann@noaa.gov prior to the December meeting. This will allow the updates to be in place for the December MACHC Meeting.

c. <u>Updates/adjustments to Region B ENC scheme</u>

There were no updates and/or adjustments at this time. But John asked for any updates to be forwarded to Jesse Friedmann in sufficient time for the December Meeting.

d. <u>Updates/resolution of overlaps in ENC coverage</u>

This was not specifically discussed. However the MICC is relying on IC-ENC to alert the group of any overlap issues.

e. Updates to arrangements with RENCS

There was nothing to report on this topic.

6. Other Business:

John Nyberg asked Chris Thorne to speak on MEIP activities. Chris noted that the Working Group has developed an approach which will be distributed in approximately one week. Chris further asked participants to come prepared for discussion with ideas to move forward.

7. Adjourn:

The Conference Call adjourned approximately at 11:00 EDT. The next meeting is scheduled for December 14, 2016 in conjunction with the 17th MACHC in Brazil.
